IWYP is working towards a goal to increase the genetic yield potential of wheat by up to 50% in the next 20 years. We aim to accomplish this primarily by optimizing the photosynthetic capability of the wheat plant and the amount of captured carbon that is sent to the developing grain.

We are calling these "IWYP Aligned Projects" and are keen to assess any research on wheat that fits the following scope of IWYP:

- Increasing carbon capture before flowering
- Optimizing overall photosynthetic efficiency & carbon mobilization
- Optimizing plant architecture and modifying phenology
- Increasing biomass
- Maximizing harvest index

Benefits of becoming an IWYP Aligned Project

- Further your own research goals by sharing and exchanging information and knowledge with other IWYP Research Projects
- Access to a broad network of researchers working in the area of genetic yield potential
- A voice in shaping the research and delivery strategies of IWYP

Requisites for IWYP Aligned Projects

- Share methods, data, information and outputs with other researchers in the IWYP program
- Be open and willing to join an IWYP steering group or committee if requested
- Agree to make available IP from the project nonexclusively on a fair and equitable basis via licenses or MTAs and on a royalty free basis to resource poor farmers
- Be willing to move successful discoveries for validation in the field and prebreeding in the IWYP Hub at CIMMYT
- Attend and present research findings at IWYP meetings and share with IWYP management a summarized research report on an annual basis
- Acknowledge IWYP in scientific publications, presentations, posters, proceedings etc., where appropriate
